WHEREAS: DECAL has partnered with local school systems and private childcare centers

in Georgia to create and support 205 inclusion classrooms in Georgia's Pre-K

Program; and

teachers meet the needs of every child in their care; and

WHEREAS: DECAL offers professional development opportunities for early learning

professionals to increase their knowledge of inclusive practices within the

classroom environment; and
