LUNG CANCER AWARENESS WEEK

- WHEREAS:** The American Lung Association celebrated 120 years of impact in 2024; and
- WHEREAS:** Lung cancer is the leading cause of cancer deaths; and
- WHEREAS:** Lung cancer screening saves lives, and advocacy and increased awareness will result in more high-risk individuals getting screened; and
- WHEREAS:** Public support for research funding will result in new treatments and better methods of early detection; and
- WHEREAS:** Lung Force is a national initiative led by the American Lung Association, to defeat lung cancer; and
- WHEREAS:** It is essential to encourage community involvement, partnerships, and advocacy efforts to sustain and expand community-based health care initiatives; and
- WHEREAS:** During Lung Cancer Awareness Week, Georgians are encouraged to learn more about lung cancer, its risk factors, early detection practices, and to take action; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim May 12-16, 2025, as LUNG CANCER AWARENESS WEEK in Georgia.
