individuals with kidney disease manage their lives while effectively dealing with their

health issues; and

WHEREAS: Organizations such as the American Nephrology Nurses Association work to advance

quality care to Americans with kidney disease before they suffer complete organ failure, increase awareness in local communities, positively influence patient outcomes, and keep nephrology nurses abreast of the latest treatments and kidney related

research; and

WHEREAS: Along with the American Nephrology Nurses Association, the State of Georgia

designates the week of September 14 through 20, 2025, as Nephrology Nurses Week to celebrate and honor the work nephrology nurses perform each day to maintain the

health of thousands of individuals with kidney disease; now
