characterized by fragile bones that break easily. People born with Osteogenesis

Imperfecta are affected throughout their lifetime; and

WHEREAS: There are different types of Osteogeneses Imperfecta with a range of severity from

mild to life threatening; and

Because there is no cure for Osteogenesis Imperfecta, treatment focuses on WHEREAS:

minimizing fractures, the surgical correction of deformity, reducing bone fragility,

maximizing mobility and independent function; and

WHEREAS: Increased funding for education and research is needed to help find more effective

treatments; and

National Osteogenesis Imperfecta Awareness Week, to encourage members of the
