aims to raise awareness about this rare disease, support affected families, and

WHEREAS: It is crucial to educate our communities about Sanfilippo Syndrome to foster

understanding, compassion, and support for those living with the condition and their

families; and

WHEREAS: Efforts to advance research and increase public awareness are essential to improving

the quality of life for individuals with Sanfilippo Syndrome and advancing towards

effective treatments; and

WHEREAS: On this day, we honor the strength and resilience of individuals and families affected

by Sanfilippo Syndrome and recognize the tireless efforts of research, healthcare

professionals, and advocates dedicated to making a difference; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

November 16, 2025, as SANFILIPPO AWARENESS DAY in Georgia.
