management, helping students learn and thrive; and

WHEREAS:

School nurses function as a liaison to the school community, parents, and health care providers by promoting wellness, and bridge health and education to improve each child's cognitive, physical, social, and emotional development; and

WHEREAS:

On School Nurse Day, the State of Georgia proudly celebrates and recognizes the contributions that school nurses are making to the health and learning of students across the Peach State; and

WHEREAS:

School nurses play a critical role for students, ensuring that they are ready for learning by managing conditions, encouraging physical and mental health; and

WHEREAS:

School nurses rise to the daily challenge of juggling a complex array of medical and social issues. They can be healers, comforters, educators, mentors, role models, and are critically needed members in a school district and school community; now

I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim May 7, 2025, as SCHOOL NURSE DAY in Georgia.
