WHEREAS: Nonprofit organizations such as Canine Companions enhance the lives of people with

disabilities by providing expertly trained service dogs and ongoing support to ensure

the inclusivity of all citizens; and

WHEREAS: Organizations across the state offer resources to educate Georgians of all walks of life

about the benefits of service dogs and the laws protecting them; and

WHEREAS: During Service Dog Month, the State of Georgia recognizes and celebrates the

invaluable impact that trained service dogs have on the everyday lives of countless

Georgians; now

**THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim September

2025, as SERVICE DOG MONTH in Georgia.
