A PROCLAMATION

TAMIL WEEK

WHEREAS: The week of February 21 through February 27 is designated as தமிழ் வாரம்

(Tamil Week) – a week recognizing the Tamil Language and the many contributions Tamil people have made to the State of Georgia and around the

world; and

WHEREAS: Tamil is one of the oldest surviving classical languages, with a recorded history

and archeological evidence dating back over two millennia; and

WHEREAS: Tamil has a rich literary tradition dating back to ancient times, with a vast array

of classical literature encompassing poetry, epics, philosophical works, and religious texts. There is also a long tradition of arts, architecture, music, dance,

and drama within the Tamil culture and language; and

WHEREAS: The Tamil-American community in this state continues to positively impact the

social, educational, economic, and cultural fabric of Georgia, including

promoting Tamil language, arts, culture, and heritage; and

WHEREAS: Georgia Tamils are committed to sharing their vibrant culture, rich traditions,

and longstanding history with the people of Georgia by celebrating Tamil Week and promoting the Tamil language, education, arts, culture, charity, and heritage;

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

February 21, 2025 - February 27, 2025, as TAMIL WEEK in Georgia.

In witness thereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of the Executive Department to be affixed this 29st day of January in the year of our Lord, Two Thousand and Twenty-Five.
