A PROCLAMATION

VOICE DAY

- WHEREAS:** The human voice is a precious instrument expressing feelings, personality, and identity; and
- WHEREAS:** An estimated 28 million Americans have some voice condition that impairs their ability to communicate easily; and
- WHEREAS:** A diagnosis of a voice disorder can be life-altering, affecting your relationships, employment, social activities, and self-esteem; and
- WHEREAS:** There is a need for greater recognition and understanding of the impact of voice disorders both in the public and within the medical community; and
- WHEREAS:** April 16 is World Voice Day, a day dedicated to recognizing the significance of the voice in our lives and understanding the challenges faced by those living with voice disorders; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim April 16, 2025, as VOICE DAY in Georgia.
