A PROCLAMATION

VOICE DAY

WHEREAS: The human voice is a precious instrument expressing feelings, personality, and identity;

and

WHEREAS: An estimated 28 million Americans have some voice condition that impairs their ability

to communicate easily; and

WHEREAS: A diagnosis of a voice disorder can be life-altering, affecting your relationships,

employment, social activities, and self-esteem; and

WHEREAS: There is a need for greater recognition and understanding of the impact of voice

disorders both in the public and within the medical community; and

WHEREAS: April 16 is World Voice Day, a day dedicated to recognizing the significance of the

voice in our lives and understanding the challenges faced by those living with voice

disorders; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim April 16,

2025, as VOICE DAY in Georgia.
