A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 7 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 Department of Economic Development, so as to create the Georgia CHIPS and Advanced
- 3 Technology Commission; to provide for the purpose, membership, and duties of such
- 4 commission; to amend Chapter 34 of Title 50, relating to the OneGeorgia Authority, so as
- 5 to abolish the Georgia CHIPS and Advanced Technology Consortium; to replace the
- 6 advisory panel and executive committee governing said consortium with the Georgia CHIPS
- 7 and Advanced Technology Commission; to provide for a definition; to provide for a sunset
- 8 date; to provide for related matters; to provide for a short title; to provide for an effective
- 9 date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 2.

15 Chapter 7 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Department

16 of Economic Development, is amended by adding a new article to read as follows:

17 "<u>ARTICLE 11</u>

- 19 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'commission' means the Georgia CHIPS and
- 20 Advanced Technology Commission established pursuant to this Code section.
- 21 (b) Subject to available funding, the commission shall be established for the purposes of:
- 22 (1) Establishing a forum for public and private stakeholders across the semiconductor
- 23 <u>manufacturing industry in this state to focus on education, research and development, and</u>
- 24 <u>commercial production;</u>
- 25 (2) Leveraging the expertise and capacity of institutions of higher education in this state,
- 26 industry, and nonprofit organizations focused on semiconductor and advanced technology
- economic and workforce development to develop a comprehensive strategic plan to
- 28 <u>ensure ongoing semiconductor innovation;</u>
- 29 (3) Advising on strategies for attracting public and private investment in this state related
- 30 to research, development, commercialization, manufacturing, and advanced packaging
- 31 of semiconductors;
- 32 (4) Identifying and expanding opportunities for workforce training and development
- related to the research, design, and manufacturing of semiconductors and related
- 34 advanced technologies;
- 35 (5) Sustaining the leadership of this state in advanced semiconductor research, design,
- manufacturing, and advanced packaging; and
- 37 (6) Encouraging the state, counties, and municipalities to attract and support the

- 39 (c) The commission shall be composed of the following members:
- 40 (1) Three members appointed by the Governor;
- 41 (2) Two members appointed by the President of the Senate;
- 42 (3) Two members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;
- 43 (4) The chancellor of the University System of Georgia or his or her designee; and
- 44 (5) The commissioner of Technical College System of Georgia or his or her designee.
