## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 8 bonds and recognizances in criminal proceedings, is amended by revising Code Section
- 9 17-6-73, relating to address of principle and surety on bond or recognizance, as follows:
- 10 "17-6-73.

- 11 Every bond or recognizance given to secure the appearance of any person in any criminal
- proceeding shall have entered thereon the <u>following legible information:</u>
- 13 (a) The full name of the principal and each surety;
- 14 (b) The mailing address of the principal and each surety;
- 15 (c) The email address of the principal and each surety; and
- 16 (d) The phone number of the principal and each surety."
