

House Bill 473 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

By: Representatives Stephens of the 164th, Hawkins of the 27th, and Newton of the 127th

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 13 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 controlled substances, so as to provide for certain provisions relating to Schedule I controlled
3 substances; to provide for certain provisions relating to the definition of dangerous drugs; to
4 provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and
5 for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Chapter 13 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to controlled
9 substances, is amended in Code Section 16-13-25, relating to Schedule I controlled
10 substances, by revising subparagraph (TT) of paragraph (1) as follows:

11 "(TT) ~~Methyl~~ 2-methyl-AP-237;"

12 **SECTION 2.**

13 Said chapter is further amended in Code Section 16-13-25, relating to Schedule I controlled
14 substances, by revising subparagraph (CC) of paragraph (3) as follows:

15 "(CC) Acetylpsilocin (4-acetoxy-N,N-dimethyltryptamine, 4-AcO-DMT); Reserved;"

SECTION 3.

Said chapter is further amended in Code Section 16-13-25, relating to Schedule I controlled substances, by adding a new subparagraph to paragraph (4) to read as follows:

"(A.5) Ethylphenidate;"

SECTION 4.

Said chapter is further amended in Code Section 16-13-25, relating to Schedule I controlled substances, by adding a new subdivision to division (13)(E)(ii) to read as follows:

"(III) Tetrahydrothiophene group;"

SECTION 5.

Said chapter is further amended in Code Section 16-13-71, relating to dangerous drug, by adding new paragraphs to subsection (b) to read as follows:

"(12.8) Acoramidis;"

88 **SECTION 6.**

89 Said chapter is further amended in Code Section 16-13-71, relating to dangerous drug, by
90 adding a new subparagraph to paragraph (59) of subsection (b) to read as follows:

91 "(ZZ.5) Peanut (arachis hypogaea) allergen powder-dnfp;"

92 **SECTION 7.**

93 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
94 without such approval.

95 **SECTION 8.**

96 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
