## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 7 of Chapter 4 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to the High Demand Apprenticeship Program, so as to provide opportunities for
- 3 apprenticeship sponsors to enter into apprenticeship program contracts with the State Board
- 4 of the Technical College System of Georgia; to provide for completion awards to
- 5 apprenticeship sponsors for the successful completion of such contracts; to provide for
- 6 related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 7 purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 SECTION 1.

- 10 Article 7 of Chapter 4 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- High Demand Apprenticeship Program, is amended in Code Section 20-4-151, relating to
- 12 purpose, employer partnerships, required information, contracts, awards, and limitations, by
- revising subsections (b), (d), and (e) and paragraph (2) of subsection (g) as follows:
- 14 "(b) An employer sponsor or apprenticeship sponsor may apply to the board for the
- opportunity to enter into a contract to perform the requirements of conducting an
- apprenticeship program for a specific apprentice. Such contract shall require the employer

sponsor's apprentice <u>or apprenticeship sponsor's apprentice</u> to successfully complete an apprenticeship program."

- 19 "(d) Upon successful completion of the requirements of a contract under this article, the
- board shall provide a contract completion award to the employer sponsor <u>or apprenticeship</u>
- 21 <u>sponsor</u>. The contract completion award amount shall be determined based on the number
- of hours of education and training required for the successful completion of the
- 23 apprenticeship under such apprenticeship program but shall not exceed:
- 24 (1) \$10,000.00 per apprentice for contracts entered into before July 1, 2024; and
- 25 (2) \$5,000.00 per apprentice for contracts entered into on or after July 1, 2024.
- 26 (e) Each employer sponsor <u>or apprenticeship sponsor</u> shall only be eligible to enter into
- 27 contracts under this article for up to:
- 28 (1) Five apprentices per year through the end of Fiscal Year 2024; and
- 29 (2) Ten apprentices per year beginning with the Fiscal Year 2025 and continuing each
- 30 fiscal year thereafter."
- 31 "(2) Provide funding to award employer sponsors or apprenticeship sponsors up
- to \$2,500.00 per apprentice 12 months after the start of his or her apprenticeship."
- 33 SECTION 2.
- 34 Said article is further amended in Code Section 20-4-154, relating to rules and regulations,
- 35 by revising paragraph (4) as follows:
- 36 "(4) The terms of agreement between an employer sponsor <u>or apprenticeship sponsor</u> and
- 37 the board."
- 38 SECTION 3.
- 39 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 40 without such approval.
