EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: There currently exist at the University of Georgia, Clarke County, Athens, Georgia, two structures on central campus identified as, building #2604 and its associated bathhouse/pavilion, and building #2605 (Legion SRVC-1), (collectively, the "Buildings") being located at 802 South Lumpkin Street on the Athens campus of the University of Georgia; and

WHEREAS: The Board of Regents, at its meeting on January 13, 2026, determined that the Buildings are no longer advantageously useful to the University of Georgia or the University System of Georgia and should be removed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY THE POWER VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby authorized to demolish and remove the Buildings from the University of Georgia, Clarke County, Athens, Georgia.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That the appropriate staff of the University of Georgia, acting under the approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, is hereby authorized to demolish the Buildings and to have all structure materials removed from the premises; all said demolition and removal to be performed as expeditiously as possible.
