**FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN GWINNETT COUNTY
ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF**

WHEREAS: Officer Pradeep Tamang, 25, with the Gwinnett County Police Department, died in the line of duty on Sunday, February 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS: Officer Tamang joined the Gwinnett County Police Department in July 2024 and graduated from the 121st Police Academy in May 2025; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Officer Tamang's service to the citizens of Gwinnett County by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and in Gwinnett County to half-staff.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE
MEMORY OF OFFICER PRADEEP TAMANG, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY
VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Gwinnett County on Saturday, February 7, 2026, the day of Officer Tamang's memorial service, until sunset.
