EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On May 12, 2026, the Governor signed House Bill 297, creating the Georgia Transportation Efficiency Authority; and

WHEREAS: The Georgia Transportation Efficiency Authority (GTEA) has the authority to approve all transportation projects within areas under non-attainment as prescribed by EPA regulation; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to Code Section 50-39-13, the Governor may delegate to the GTEA, by executive order, his power under applicable federal transportation planning laws and regulations; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to Code Section 50-39-14, the Governor may delegate to the GTEA, by executive order, powers under federal laws and regulations for approval, review, and modification(s) of state-wide transportation improvement programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That all powers vested in the Office of the Governor of the State of Georgia for approval, review, and modification(s) of Atlanta Regional Transportation Improvement Programs are hereby delegated to the Georgia Transportation Efficiency Authority.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: All prior delegations related to transportation improvement program approval within the Atlanta Metropolitan Planning Organization region are superseded by this Order.
