EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On April 7, 2026, Mr. Charles Brandon Fletcher, Coroner of Irwin County, was indicted on nine counts of Theft by Taking, six counts of Financial Transaction Card Fraud, four counts of Criminal Use of an Article with an Altered Identification Mark, three counts of Making a False Statement, and three counts of Fraudulent Use of Exemption Certificate to Avoid Taxes; and

WHEREAS: A certified copy of the above-mentioned indictment was transmitted to me pursuant to Code Section 45-5-6(b) and received on April 27, 2026; and

WHEREAS: Executive Order 05.12.26.02 was issued on May 12, 2026, appointing members to the review commission to determine whether the above-mentioned indictment relates to and adversely affects the administration of the Office of Coroner of Irwin County such that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected; and

WHEREAS: Code Section 45-5-6(c) provides that additional time may be granted by the Governor for a review commission to make its written report; and

WHEREAS: On May 26, 2026, the above-mentioned review commission requested a 30-day extension to make its written report.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 45-5-6, AND THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the period for the above-mentioned review commission to make its written report is extended to June 25, 2026.
