EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: When a vacancy occurs on the State Election Board pursuant to Code Section 21-2-30 (c), such state executive committee of each political party shall select a nominee within 30 days after a vacancy occurs in such office, and such nominee shall be immediately appointed by the Governor; and

WHEREAS: The Honorable Janice Johnston, the state executive committee of the Georgia Republican Party's nominee to the State Election Board, resigned from office on June 4, 2026; thereby creating a vacancy in such office; and

WHEREAS: By letter dated June 9, 2026, the state executive committee of the Georgia Republican Party indicated its nomination of the Honorable Carolyn Roddy to the State Election Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 21-2-30, AND THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That effective June 10, 2026, the Honorable Carolyn Roddy is appointed as a member of the State Election Board, for a term of office ending June 10, 2028, to succeed the Honorable Janice Johnston.

GOVERNOR
