## EXECUTIVE ORDER

---

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 152.183 acres of improved real property (the "Property"), by virtue of a Fee Deed Without Warranty dated January 17, 1986, from the City of Valdosta and recorded in Deed Book 489, Pages 396-399, in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Lowndes County; and

**WHEREAS:** Said Property is in the custody of the Department of Corrections and was acquired as part of Valdosta State Prison; and

**WHEREAS:** The Property is improved with various structures identified as the "South Building" (BLLIP ID# 8280), "Flammable Storage" (BLLIP ID# 8290), and "Industries Storage" (BLLIP ID# 72310) (collectively, the "Structures"), and as shown in that aerial photograph attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference; and

**WHEREAS:** Said Structures are identified by the Department of Corrections to be demolished due to the installation of the new Mod Corr units; and

**WHEREAS:** The Board of Corrections, on May 7, 2026, resolved to request the State Properties Commission seek an Executive Order from the Governor to allow for the razing, demolition, and disposal of the Structures.

**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** The Department of Corrections is hereby authorized and directed to provide for the razing, demolition and disposal of said Structures under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interests of the State of Georgia, in accordance with applicable laws, policies, and procedures, including any requirements under Code Section 12-3-55 regarding historic properties that may pertain to the Structures.
