## EXECUTIVE ORDER

---

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**WHEREAS:** On June 26, 2026, allegations of misconduct by Mr. Kenneth Henderson, Sheriff of Towns County, were brought to my attention; and

**WHEREAS:** These allegations are separate and distinct from the allegations previously investigated pursuant to Executive Order 09.19.25.02 or the indictment reviewed pursuant to Executive Order 12.02.25.01; and

**WHEREAS:** On June 27, 2026, I appointed Attorney General Christopher Carr, Sheriff Lenn Wood of Coweta County, and Sheriff Ezell Brown of Newton County as the committee to investigate the alleged misconduct of Sheriff Henderson; and

**WHEREAS:** By report dated June 27, 2026, the committee recommended that Sheriff Henderson be suspended pursuant to Code Section 15-16-26(c).

**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 15-16-26, AND THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** That Sheriff Henderson is hereby suspended from the Office of Sheriff of Towns County for a period of 60 days, effective immediately.
