EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia leases approximately 1,775.74 acres of improved real property in Bartow County (hereinafter the "Property") from the United States Secretary of the Army pursuant to a 25-year lease which commenced September 15, 2006, which lease is recorded in the State Properties Commission Real Property Records as RPR# 010293; and
- WHEREAS:** Said Property is in the custody of the Department of Natural Resources (hereinafter the "Department") and is operated as Red Top Mountain State Park; and
- WHEREAS:** The Property is improved with a well house consisting of 80 square feet (BLLIP #29026) (hereinafter the "Structure"), which is owned by the State of Georgia and as shown in that location map attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference; and
- WHEREAS:** The Department is desirous of demolishing the Structure due to significant disrepair; and
- WHEREAS:** By official action dated January 30, 2026, the Board of Natural Resources requested the authority from the State Properties Commission to seek an Executive Order from the Governor to allow for the razing, demolition, and disposal of the Structure; and

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

- ORDERED:** The Department of Natural Resources is hereby authorized and directed to raze, demolish and dispose of said Structure under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interests of the State of Georgia, in accordance with applicable laws, policies, and procedures, including any requirements under O.C.G.A. § 12-3-55 regarding historic properties that may pertain to the Structure.
