BY THE GOVERNOR:

**FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN
MERIWETHER, FAYETTE, AND HEARD COUNTIES
ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF**

- WHEREAS:** Sergeant Christopher Durran Fisher, 36, with the Warm Springs Police Department, died in the line of duty on September 2, 2026; and
- WHEREAS:** With the heart of a public servant, Sgt. Fisher was passionate about his service as a law enforcement officer and was a great representative of the public safety community; and
- WHEREAS:** Prior to his service with the Warm Springs Police Department, Sgt. Fisher worked for the Meriwether County Sheriff's Office, Fayette County Sheriff's Office, and Heard County Sheriff's Office; and
- WHEREAS:** Sgt. Fisher also proudly served his country for five years in the United States Army as a Transportation Specialist; and
- WHEREAS:** It is fitting and proper to recognize Sgt. Fisher's service to his fellow Georgians by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and in Meriwether, Fayette, and Heard Counties to half-staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF SGT. CHRISTOPHER DURRAN FISHER, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

- ORDERED:** That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Meriwether, Fayette, and Heard Counties on Tuesday, September 8, 2026, the day of Sgt. Fisher's interment, until sunset.
