EXECUTIVE ORDER

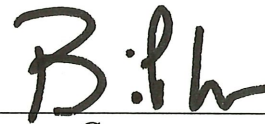
BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 1.4 acres of improved real property (the "Property") by virtue of a Warranty Deed dated August 6, 1954, from Mose Gordon and recorded in Deed Book 147, Page 309, in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Hall County being inventoried and recorded as Real Property Record number 00736; and
- WHEREAS:** Said Property is in the custody of the Georgia Forestry Commission and was acquired as part of the Hall County Fire Tower; and
- WHEREAS:** The Property is improved with a structure identified as the "Residence" (BLLIP ID# 36176) (the "Structure"), and as shown in that aerial map attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference; and
- WHEREAS:** The Georgia Forestry Commission has ceased to utilize the Structure due to deterioration and desires to demolish the Structure; and
- WHEREAS:** The Georgia Forestry Commission Board, on August 25, 2026, resolved to request the State Properties Commission seek an Executive Order from the Governor to allow for the razing, demolition, and disposal of the Structure; and

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

- ORDERED:** The Georgia Forestry Commission is hereby authorized and directed to provide for the razing, demolition and disposal of said Structure under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interest of the State of Georgia, in accordance with applicable laws, policies, and procedures, including any requirements under Code Section 12-3-55, regarding historic properties that may pertain to the Structure.
