## A PROCLAMATION

### 770 DAY

- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia and the Metro Atlanta region experienced significant growth during the latter half of the twentieth century and continue to serve as a center of economic opportunity, innovation, and cultural diversity; and
- WHEREAS:** The 770 area code was established in 1995 as part of the North American Numbering Plan and has since become associated with many of the communities that surround the City of Atlanta; and
- WHEREAS:** 770 area code communities have played a vital role in the growth and prosperity of Georgia through their contributions to commerce, transportation, education, public service, culture, and entrepreneurship; and
- WHEREAS:** South Metro Atlanta, often recognized as Atlanta's Backyard and Global Front Door, is home to diverse communities and critical assets including Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport, one of the world's busiest transportation hubs; and
- WHEREAS:** The observance of 770 Day provides an opportunity to promote civic pride, community service, local business engagement, cultural appreciation, youth empowerment, and regional collaboration throughout Georgia, celebrated by residents and organizations with strong contributions to the State who are represented by the 770 area code; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim July 7<sup>th</sup>, 2026, as 770 DAY in Georgia.

In witness thereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of the Executive Department to be affixed this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June in the year of our Lord, Two Thousand and Twenty-Six.
