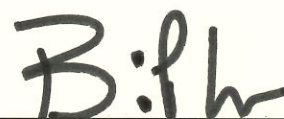
A PROCLAMATION

CAREERS IN ENERGY WEEK

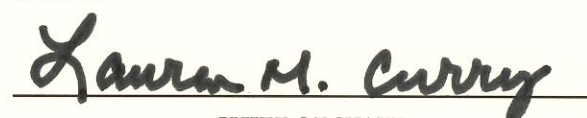
- WHEREAS:** Citizens across the state of Georgia rely on energy as a fundamental part of everyday life; and
