A PROCLAMATION

**CHILDREN’S ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH
DAY**

- WHEREAS:** The goal of Children’s Environmental Health Day is to raise awareness on the importance of clean air and water, safe food and consumer products, healthy environments, and stable climates to safeguard children’s health and development across the nation; and
- WHEREAS:** CEH Day was created by the Children’s Environmental Health Network and celebrated for the first time on October 13, 2016, and it continues to be observed the second Thursday of every October to uphold the children’s environmental health movement through encouraged advocacy and raised awareness; and
- WHEREAS:** CEH Day is a national effort supported by individuals, non-profit organizations, and government agencies who seek improved protection for all children and perform acts of sustainability or environmental health wellness; and
- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia— the top state to live, work, and raise a family-- recognizes this day to protect its most vulnerable population: children; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim October 8th, 2026, as CHILDREN’S ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH DAY in Georgia.
