A PROCLAMATION

ECONOMIC EDUCATION MONTH

- WHEREAS:** Economics is the study of sound decision making while managing scarce resources, and is an essential skill for all people; and
- WHEREAS:** Economic education equips students with skills and tools for future societal roles as productive workers, informed consumers and savers, involved citizens, and lifelong decision-makers in a globally interdependent world; and
- WHEREAS:** Society and democracy depend on active involvement of economically literate citizens who are able to understand and evaluate critical issues of public policy; and
- WHEREAS:** Economic education is encouraged in all education divisions, but basic principles are learned best during the K-12 years. Even the youngest of children are capable of comprehending basic economic concepts that help them understand the world around them; and
- WHEREAS:** In Georgia, K-12 educators are equipped with high quality training and resources to ensure students have access to classroom lessons that develop the skills necessary to make informed choices as citizens; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim October 2026, as ECONOMIC EDUCATION MONTH in Georgia.
