the first program of its kind in the country; and

of 18 months; and

WHEREAS:

Each hospital-based facility dog has a Children's employee handler who is responsible

for caring and managing the dog; and

WHEREAS:

Children's Healthcare of Atlanta employs 16 full-time facility dogs in various

departments, including the Arthur M. Blank, Scottish Rite, Hughes Spalding Hospitals

and the Zalik Behavioral and Mental Health Center; and

WHEREAS:

Canines For Kids is a goal-directed program that helps patients cope, heal and achieve

treatment goals to ensure Children's Healthcare of Atlanta is doing everything possible

to make anything possible for kids; now

THEREFORE:

I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim January

15th 2026, as FACILITY DOGS DAY in Georgia.
