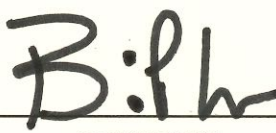
A PROCLAMATION

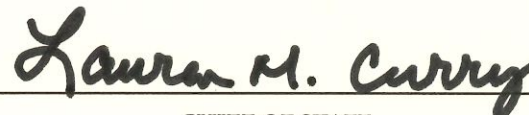
FLEET DAY

- WHEREAS:** The Fleet Management Division (FMD) of the Georgia Department of Administrative Services, under the direction of and in partnership with the Governor's Office of Planning and Budget, in accordance with State Policy 10 Purchase and Use of Motor Vehicles, and its partners, provides cost-effective oversight of over 20,000 Georgia fleet vehicles, ensuring their efficient management from initial acquisition through disposal, contributing to the states operational efficiency and public safety; and
- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia continues to advance fleet operations through the strategic use of data and modern technologies, including telematics and maintenance-tracking systems, to strengthen safety, control costs, improve asset performance, and streamline the leasing, ownership, fueling, and maintenance of state vehicles; and
- WHEREAS:** State fleet management leaders provide guidance grounded in industry best practices and compliance with state policies, ensuring that state vehicle drivers have the tools, training, and resources needed to navigate Georgias roads safely and confidently; and
- WHEREAS:** In July 2026, the State of Georgia implemented the new Element Fleet Management system, a significant modernization initiative requiring extensive planning, business-process review, system configuration, data cleansing and validation, testing, issue resolution, training, communications, and operational-readiness activities, The State of Georgia recognizes the exceptional dedication of FMD staff, agency fleet managers, fleet professionals, and implementation partners whose collaboration and expertise helped maintain continuity of service and ensure a successful system transition; and
- WHEREAS:** Fleet Day brings together state fleet leaders, managers, professionals, and contracted suppliers to exchange knowledge, strengthen professional networks, and share leading national and state practices, policies, and techniques that promote collaboration, consistency, and operational excellence across state government. The observance of Fleet Day serves as an opportunity to honor the hard work, dedication, and professionalism of those who manage, operate, and maintain our state's fleet and whose service helps keep state government moving safely and efficiently; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim October 30, 2026, as FLEET DAY in Georgia.
