WHEREAS: Municipal Court Clerks are committed to maintaining neutrality and impartiality, providing equal service to all, and upholding the standards set forth in the Uniform Rules for Municipal Courts of the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS: Municipal Court Clerks serve nearly 400 municipal courts across the State of Georgia and play a critical role in the effective administration of justice; and

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia recognizes and appreciates the contributions of Municipal Court Clerks and their positive impact on Georgia's communities; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim June 8-12, 2026, as GEORGIA MUNICIPAL COURT CLERKS WEEK in Georgia.
