WHEREAS: All children in Georgia should have access to the highest-quality education possible;

WHEREAS: Quality education is critically important to the economic vitality of Georgia. Georgia

WHEREAS: Educational variety not only helps to diversify our economy but also enhances the

vibrancy of our community. Georgia has many high-quality teaching professionals in
