A PROCLAMATION

HONORING OUR CAREGIVERS WEEK

- WHEREAS:** Caregivers across the State of Georgia, including family members, friends, neighbors, and professional direct care workers, provide essential and compassionate support to children, older adults, individuals with disabilities, and persons living with chronic or acute health conditions; and
- WHEREAS:** More than one million Georgians serve in caregiving roles, often performing complex medical, emotional, and logistical tasks that enable care recipients to remain in their homes and communities, thereby lessening demands on long-term care facilities and the healthcare system; and
- WHEREAS:** The immeasurable contributions of caregivers strengthen Georgia's families, communities, and economy, representing billions of dollars in unpaid labor each year and supporting the dignity, stability, and independence of countless residents; and
- WHEREAS:** Caregivers frequently shoulder their responsibilities while managing employment, education, and personal obligations and are deserving of increased access to supportive services, respite opportunities, training, financial resources, and workplace accommodations; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim June 7-13, 2026, as HONORING OUR CAREGIVERS WEEK in Georgia.
