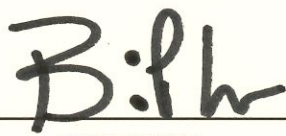
A PROCLAMATION

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY MONTH

- WHEREAS:** Intellectual Property plays a significant role in Georgia’s economy by incentivizing investments in knowledge, innovations, and inventions. Georgia is creating a world-class Intellectual Property ecosystem for social good through partnerships with creators, protectors, and enablers; and
- WHEREAS:** The Georgia Intellectual Property Alliance, Georgia Bar Association, Atlanta Bar Association, Georgia Lawyers for the Arts, Georgia Chamber of Commerce, Metro Atlanta Chamber of Commerce, Georgia Research Alliance, Technology Association of Georgia, Advanced Technology Development Center, participating universities, and many others play an important role in Georgia’s Intellectual Property success; and
- WHEREAS:** In 2020, the Georgia Intellectual Property Alliance launched the U.S. Intellectual Property Alliance. Likewise, in 2022, the U.S. Intellectual Property Alliance launched the Global Intellectual Property Alliance. Both are headquartered in Georgia and educate many people across America and the world with intellectual property programs and resources; and
- WHEREAS:** Georgia’s leadership in Intellectual Property supports businesses, IP providers, and IP students contributing to the state's thriving technology and creative media sectors. Leadership and innovation in areas such as Intellectual Property set Georgia apart as the best state to live, work, and raise a family; and
- WHEREAS:** In October and early November 2026, the Georgia Intellectual Property Alliance hosts the annual Corporate IP Institute, the annual Charitable IP (CIP CUP) Golf Tournament, the annual Health, Hope, Heroes 5K, and the triennial IP Community Service Awards, to honor volunteer IP contributors in Georgia; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim October 2026 as INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY MONTH in Georgia.

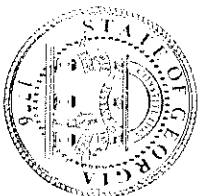
