- WHEREAS:** Law enforcement personnel answer calls for service in moments of crisis, support victims and families, respond to emergencies, and work in partnership with residents, schools, businesses, faith communities, and public safety agencies throughout Georgia; and
- WHEREAS:** The safety and well-being of Georgia communities depend on strong collaboration among law enforcement, security professionals, emergency responders, civic leaders, and the public; and
- WHEREAS:** Law Enforcement Appreciation Day provides an opportunity for Georgians to recognize the commitment, sacrifice, and service of the men and women who serve in law enforcement roles across the state; and
- WHEREAS:** The ASIS International Greater Atlanta Chapter joins community partners in honoring Georgia's law enforcement professionals and promoting continued partnership, respect, and shared responsibility for public safety; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim August 20, 2026 as LAW ENFORCEMENT APPRECIATION DAY in Georgia.
