MEDICAL LABORATORY PROFESSIONALS WEEK


- WHEREAS:** Medical diagnosis and treatment decisions rely heavily on timely and accurate clinical laboratory test results; and

- WHEREAS:** The exacting standards of modern medical practice require scientific precision of clinical and public health tests performed daily by laboratory professionals; and
- WHEREAS:** The medical and public health fields rely on the dedicated efforts of laboratory professionals to maintain the high standards of quality in laboratory practice; and
- WHEREAS:** Medical Laboratory Professionals Week strives to keep the public well-informed about the medical laboratory practice and competency to provide highest possible healthcare quality and accountability that Georgians deserve; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim April 19-25, 2026, as MEDICAL LABORATORY PROFESSIONALS WEEK in Georgia.
