A PROCLAMATION

MEDICARE AWARENESS DAY

- WHEREAS:** June 4th serves as a reminder of age 64, an important time for individuals to begin preparing for Medicare eligibility prior to turning 65, the age when most Americans first become eligible for Medicare; and
- WHEREAS:** More than 10,000 Americans and approximately 350 Georgia residents turn 65 each day, highlighting the importance of accessible and reliable information so individuals can understand Medicare eligibility and prepare for enrollment before reaching age 65; and
- WHEREAS:** Individuals who are unaware of Medicare enrollment timelines may miss important enrollment periods, which can result in delays in coverage, gaps in coverage, or potential lifetime penalties; and
- WHEREAS:** Increased public education and awareness can help individuals and families better understand Medicare and prepare in advance so they can make informed healthcare decisions; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim June 4, 2026, as MEDICARE AWARENESS DAY in Georgia.
