**MOBILE INTEGRATED HEALTHCARE
WEEK**

- WHEREAS:** The needs of chronically ill patients often go untreated because of gaps in the healthcare system and Mobile Integrated Healthcare delivers innovative, patient-centered care directly to individuals in their homes and communities; and
- WHEREAS:** Mobile Integrated Healthcare models have become a core element of rural health transformation across the nation and enhance access to quality, affordable healthcare that advances health outcomes in Georgia; and
- WHEREAS:** The goal of Mobile Integrated Healthcare is to prevent the over-utilization of emergency departments and emergency medical services for non-emergency conditions, to improve the quality of life of patients, and to improve overall public health by addressing both social and healthcare needs; and
- WHEREAS:** Georgias fire departments, EMS agencies, hospitals, and public health partners have advanced Mobile Integrated Healthcare through programs providing health assessments, chronic disease management, preventive care, medication management, and post-hospital discharge follow-up visits to residents in both urban and rural communities across the state; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim October 4-10, 2026, as MOBILE INTEGRATED HEALTHCARE WEEK in Georgia.
