NATIONAL ASSISTED LIVING WEEK

- WHEREAS: Dedicated caregivers, nurses, administrators, support staff, volunteers, and family members work tirelessly to create a safe environment to enhance the quality of life for residents each day; and
- WHEREAS: National Assisted Living Week, established by the National Center for Assisted Living, is an annual celebration recognizing the important role assisted living communities play in supporting the well-being of Georgia's aging population; and
- WHEREAS: The 2026 theme, "Joyful Moments," celebrates the meaningful connections and shared experiences that bring happiness and purpose to residents, families, and caregivers while recognizing the positive impact of compassionate care; and
- WHEREAS: Georgia's assisted living providers continue to demonstrate an unwavering commitment to delivering high-quality care and fostering communities where residents can thrive with respect and opportunities for meaningful engagement; now
- THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim September 13-19, 2026, as NATIONAL ASISSTED LIVING WEEK in Georgia.
