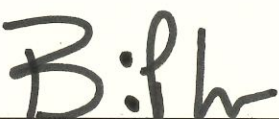
A PROCLAMATION

NATIONAL FIRST RESPONDERS DAY

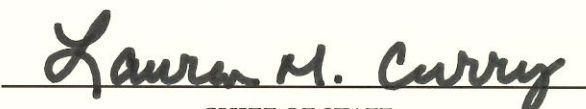
