RONALD REAGAN DAY

WHEREAS: President Ronald Wilson Reagan, a man of humble background, having been employed as an entertainer, Union leader, governor of California and president of the United States; and

WHEREAS: Reagan served for two terms as the 40th president of the United States of America; the second of which he earned the confidence of three-fifths of the electorate and was victorious in 49 of the 50 states in the general election – a record unsurpassed in the history of American presidential elections; and


WHEREAS: In 1981, when Reagan was inaugurated President, he inherited a disillusioned nation shackled by rampant inflation and high unemployment; and
