A PROCLAMATION

SENIOR WEEK

- WHEREAS:** In 1977 the State of Georgia authorized the establishment of the Georgia Council on Aging to serve as trusted advisors to the States leadership regarding areas of concern being faced by Georgias elderly citizens; and
- WHEREAS:** The Coalition of Advocates for Georgias Elderly (CO-AGE) was established by the Council to provide a means through which members of the aging network could collaborate and identify the most pressing issues facing seniors across our state; and
- WHEREAS:** Georgia's 1.7 million citizens 65 and older represents 15.8% of the state's population and is the fastest growing segment of the population; and
- WHEREAS:** These citizens provide invaluable resources and contributions to Georgia's overall position as one of the best places to live; and
- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia encourages its citizens to participate in events each year during this week designed to highlight the partnerships and support of state and local leaders that provide members of the aging community the opportunity to come together to celebrate and recognize the contributions of Georgias seniors; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim February 8-14th, 2026, as SENIOR WEEK in Georgia.
