- WHEREAS:** During Asian American and Pacific Islander Heritage Month, we celebrate Taiwanese American Heritage Week and recognize the contributions of Taiwanese Americans to the cultural, economic, and social fabric of the State of Georgia; and
- WHEREAS:** Organizations across the state provide Taiwanese Americans in Georgia with support, camaraderie, and valuable networking opportunities; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim May 10-17, 2026, as TAIWANESE AMERICAN HERITAGE WEEK in Georgia.
