### TENNIS MONTH

- WHEREAS:** The United States Tennis Association (USTA), the Georgia Tennis Association (USTA Georgia) and the Georgia Tennis Foundation (GTF) promote the play and growth of the sport of tennis in Georgia at every age, ability and level of play from beginners to touring professionals; and
- WHEREAS:** Playing tennis at any level of ability improves heart health, agility and can provide a positive and fun environment to spend time with family and friends while staying active; and
- WHEREAS:** By increasing accessibility of tennis for Georgians of all ages and abilities, USTA Georgia and the Georgia Tennis Foundation have helped make Georgia communities healthier; and
- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia has declared the month of May as National Tennis Month in partnership with USTA to encourage players, organizations, facilities, retailers, tennis manufacturers and many other tennis providers to promote local programs and activities at public parks and facilities, private clubs, schools, college and universities to showcase tennis and spread the word about the sport and its benefits, and to help players and non-players alike find courts and play opportunities in their communities; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim May 2026, as TENNIS MONTH in Georgia.
