A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 13 of Chapter 2 of Title 26 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,  
2 relating to food service establishments, so as to require notification of foreign imported  
3 shrimp; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

6 Article 13 of Chapter 2 of Title 26 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
7 food service establishments, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

8 "26-2-378.1.

9 All food service establishments in this state that serve foreign imported shrimp shall  
10 conspicuously display on their menus a disclosure by each menu item containing shrimp  
11 stating 'FOREIGN IMPORTED,' or on placards visible to the public 'FOREIGN  
12 IMPORTED SHRIMP.' This Code section shall not apply to a food service establishment  
13 operated by a state agency, as such term is defined in Code Section 48-8-14."

15 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
