EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On September 1, 2019, due to the likely impact of Hurricane Dorian to the

state of Georgia, I ordered the mandatory evacuation of all persons east of

Interstate 95 along Georgia's coast; and

WHEREAS: To expedite the evacuation of those aforementioned persons, I ordered the

westerly contraflow of Interstate 16; and

WHEREAS: After Hurricane Dorian impacts Georgia's coast, Interstate 16 will be a

critical roadway to deliver life sustaining resources and allow first

responders to perform re-entry operations; and

WHEREAS: Georgia law vests the Governor in O.C.G.A. § 38-3-51 with the authority to

bring emergency situations under control by issuing orders, rules, and

regulations to protect the safety and welfare of the public.

NOW THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That operations to cease westerly contraflow of Interstate 16 will begin

Wednesday, September 4, 2019, at 12:00 PM to allow entry of essential

services to the affected area.
