## EXECUTIVE ORDER

---

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**WHEREAS:** Pursuant to Section 142 of Title 13 of the United States Code, the next federal, decennial census will occur on April 1, 2020; and

**WHEREAS:** On November 7, 2017, Governor Nathan Deal issued an Executive Order creating and appointing the Governor's Complete Count Committee to develop and coordinate a census outreach program for 2020; and

**WHEREAS:** The Complete Count Committee, a diverse, volunteer task force with members representing every region of Georgia, will utilize its collective knowledge, expertise, and influence to ensure that every resident of Georgia is counted in the upcoming census; and

**WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia is committed to an accurate, collaborative, and complete count of the population given this decennial event's long-term impact on congressional and state apportionment as well as federal funding for programs that assist residents of the Peach State.

**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** That the Governor's Complete Count Committee is hereby appointed.
