EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 1.137 +/- acres of improved real property (hereinafter the "Property") located at 3295 Fort Morris Road, Midway, Georgia 31320, located in the 1359th General Militia District, Liberty County, Georgia, acquired by virtue of a deed dated December 19, 2018, recorded in Deed Book 2015, pages 728-730, in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Liberty County, and filed with the State Properties Commission Real Property Records as RPR# 12240; and

WHEREAS: Said Property is in the custody of the Georgia Department Natural Resources; and

WHEREAS: The Property is known as the Brogdon Tract and is improved with a house ("Structure") as shown in the aerial photograph attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS: Said Structure has been identified by the Georgia Department of Natural Resources as heavily damaged, in poor condition, and of no value to the Department; and

WHEREAS: By letter dated August 27, 2019, the Georgia Department of Natural Resources requested permission to demolish the Structure in order to add to the existing boat ramp to increase recreational opportunities for fishing and boating on Midway River and provide overflow parking.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: The Georgia Department of Natural Resources is authorized and directed to provide for the razing, demolition, and disposal of said Structure under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interests of the State of Georgia.
