



# THE STATE OF GEORGIA

## EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 4.642 acres of improved real property (hereinafter the "Property") located at 935 United Avenue, S.E. (formerly known as East Confederate Ave.), lying and being in Land Lot 10, 14<sup>th</sup> District, Atlanta, Georgia 30316, by virtue of a deed dated November 26, 1901, from The Confederate Soldiers Home of Georgia and being recorded in Deed Book I, page 60-66 in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Fulton County; and

**WHEREAS:** Said Property is in the custody of the Georgia Department of Public Safety ("DPS") by virtue of an Executive Order dated August 9, 2019, transferring custody from the Georgia Department of Defense to the Department of Public Safety, and being inventoried and recorded as Real Property Record # 12303; and

**WHEREAS:** The Property is improved with buildings 4, 21, and 22 on Tract J (hereinafter the "Structures") as shown in the aerial photograph attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

**WHEREAS:** By Resolution dated October 10, 2019, the Georgia Board of Public Safety declared no further use of the Structures, as the useful life had expired, and recommended demolition in favor of future facilities that will benefit the Georgia Department of Public Safety operations and law enforcement purposes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** The Georgia Department of Public Safety is authorized and directed to provide for the razing, demolition, and disposal of said Structures under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interests of the State of Georgia.
