BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS:

The state of Georgia mourns the loss of former state Senator Leroy

Johnson who passed away on October 24, 2019; and

WHEREAS:

Senator Leroy Johnson served in the Georgia State Senate from 1963

- 1975; and

WHEREAS:

Senator Johnson was the first African-American elected to serve in

the Georgia State Senate since Reconstruction.

Now, therefore, in honor of and as a mark of respect for the memory of Senator Leroy Johnson, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the state of

GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED:

That the flag of the United States and the flag of the state of Georgia shall be flown at half-staff on the Georgia State Capitol on Thursday,

October 31, 2019.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED:

That the flag of the United States and the flag of the state of Georgia shall be flown at half-staff on all state buildings and grounds throughout Georgia on Friday, November 1, 2019, the day of Senator

Johnson's interment.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED:

That the Honorable Leroy Johnson shall lie in state in the Rotunda

of the Georgia State Capitol on Thursday, October 31, 2019, from

11:00 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.
